Now, with over 64,000 members and 28 financial centers in Alabama and Georgia, Five Star is committed to brightening the future of its members and communities.

In 1991, Cedar Springs Federal Credit Union changed its name to Five Star Federal Credit Union. The headquarters moved to Dothan in 1997. Eventually dropping the "federal" from its name, Five Star became more community-focused and saw major growth throughout the 2010s, expanding into new markets in Georgia and reaching smaller communities where banking options were limited. The success over the past 60 years is a testament to the trust and loyalty of our members and the dedication of our employees.
